THIRD PETITION TO DETERMINE SUCCESSION TO REAL PROPERTY (ESTATES <\$166,250)

TENTATIVE RULING: The petition is continued to May 21, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. B. Following a continuance to allow petitioner to file an amended petition and to correct numerous issues, on December 22, 2020, the Court denied without prejudice petitioner’s first petition to determine succession to real property. The Court denied without prejudice petitioner’s second petition to determine succession to real property as numerous defects remained.

For the third petition, petitioner has remedied many of the issues identified in previous minute orders. However, petitioner did not include Attachment 14 or serve Marc Molnar. This attachment lists the names, relationships to decedent, ages, and residence or mailing addresses of (1) all persons named or checked in items 1, 9, and 10; (2) all other heirs of decedent; and (3) all devisees of decedent (persons designated in the will to receive any property). This list needs to include Christina Bonnevie, Hector Lim, Christopher Bonnevie, Cristobal Bonnevie, Marc Molnar, and any other relevant individuals. In addition, Molnar was not served with the third petition. Petitioner shall serve all interested parties, including Molnar, with the third petition with Attachment 14 and file the proof of service for the next hearing date.
