Dear Members of the Napa County Grand Jury:

Thank you for your efforts in reviewing and commenting on the Napa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District for Flood Protection Sales Tax.

The City was requested by the 2009-2010 Grand Jury for an updated response to recommendation 2.

The City provides the following comments related to the Grand Jury's question, "With the resolution of pending lawsuits, what is the current status of the flood control project?"

The City has not waivered from the progress of the flood control project. Phase one of the project was accepted by City Council in March. Phase II of the flood control project is underway. The City anticipates the project to be completed this fall.

The City intends to initiate design, engineering and construction on remaining components authorized by Measure A when the project currently being constructed is complete and funding is available. Where Measure A provides for additional projects in St. Helena it does not obligate the City to construct all projects.
