Re: Grand Jury Investigative Report – Operations of the Napa County Public Defender's Office Report Date: May 31, 2022

Dear Michael Stone and members of the Napa County Grand Jury 2021-2022:

I am in receipt of a copy of the 2021-2022 Napa County Grand Jury's report on the operations of the Napa County Public Defender's Office. Pursuant to PC 933.05, please find my responses:

- F1 Agree
- F2 Agree in part. A guilty plea by a non-United States citizen misdemeanor defendant
 can have additional serious consequences including deportation or removal on the
 charges and/or deportation or removal on future charges. I know of no procedure,
 policy or set of circumstances that would result in an immediate departure.
- F3 Agree
- F4 Agree
- F5 Agree in part. I would agree that if pleas are going to be taken by the court at arraignment, the presence of a Public Defender would increase the likelihood that criminal defendants understand the consequences of their plea. If the court decides that no pleas will be taken by unrepresented misdemeanor defendants at arraignment, the presence of the Public Defender at the arraignment would be irrelevant.
- F6 I cannot agree or disagree. I have no independent knowledge of the budgetary and/or staffing issues faced by the Public Defender's Office.
- F7 Agree. Napa County is extremely well-served by the professionalism, scholarship and commitment of our Public Defender's Office
- R1 Agree in part. This issue is easily remedied by asking the court not to take pleas of
 unrepresented misdemeanor defendants. If the court is unamenable to a collaborative
 approach to these important issues and the Public Defender is in need of extra staffing,
 I would join in the recommendation.

Thank you for your work on this and surely many other important matters in this County.
